Engineers must not leave the throttle while trains are in motion to oil cylinders, fix headlights, or for any other purpose. If it becomes necessary for an Engineer to leave his post, the train must be stopped.

Rapid Transit trains will stop at all Rapid Transit Stations.

All trains must approach Van Wicklens and Woodhaven cautiously, looking out for Rapid Transit trains.

All Passenger and Freight trains must pull into Flatbush Yard with great care.

Trains must not exceed a speed of 5 Miles per hour in going in or out of the Flatbush Ave. Depot.

Engineers must keep trains under full control and run at uniform schedule speed, particularly within the city limits.

All Local Rapid Transit Engines with or without trains must use FIVE MINUTES between East New York and Van Wicklens.

Irregular, Special, Extra ör Wild-Cat trains must not be moved outside of Station Yards without orders in writing from the Master of Transportation's Office.

Rear Brakemen, when on duty, must be on the rear end of last car of their train and have a Red Flag, Red Lantern and Torpedoes ready for instant use.

Engineers must approach all Meeting, Junction, Telegraph, Terminal and Emportant Stations, slowly, with their Trains under full control, and not run ahead of schedule time under any circumstances.

No train must occupy, or cross, or in any way use a track over which it is not scheduled or ordered in writing, without signalmen out in both directions to protect it from approaching trains, whether such trains are expected or not.

Engineers must keep a sharp look out on the signal box in front of the Master of Transportation's office, and at Cross-over Switches at west end of yard at East New York and not pass those points unless white signal is displayed.

Engineers must not use the blower, or allow steam to escape from the safety valve in Flatbush yard or between Bedford Station and Flatbush Ayenue Depot.

The Vacuum Brakes must be tested before the train is started from terminal Stations, to see that it is in working order, and properly coupled. Conductors must see that their trains are supplied at all times with extra hose, couplings, etc.

The whistle must not be sounded within the city limits, except when absolutely necessary to avoid accident.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MUST ANY TRAIN EXCEED SCHEDULE SPEED BETWEEN EAST NEW YORK AND FLATBUSH AVENUE DEPOT.

When trains on the Atlantic Division and on the Long Island Road or Montauk Division approach Jamaica, Eastbound, at the same time, the Long Island or Montauk Division train must be allowed to reach the Station in advance of the Atlantic Division train.

Atlantic Division Conductors and Brakemen must exercise the utmost care in discharging passengers from their trains across the main line tracks in front of the Jamaica Depot, and see that the track is clear before allowing them to cross.

Passenger Conductors, Baggage Masters and Brakemen are required to dress neatly, wear the prescribed uniform and regulation cap, abstain from smoking while on duty, and at all times treat passengers with uniform courtesy and politeness. The careless handling of baggage, or a disregard for the comfort of the patrons of the road, will be considered sufficient cause for dismissal from the Company's service.

Conductors, Engineers, Firemen, and other trainmen, must not smoke while on duty, nor about the Stations or trains at any time.

THE ATTENTION OF AGENTS, CONDUCTORS, ENGINEERS AND OTHERS IS CALLED TO THE FOLLOW-ING STATE LAW:

"In forming a passenger train, baggage, freight, merchandise or lumber cars shall not be placed in rear of passenger cars; or if they or any of them shall be so placed the officer or agent who so directed, or knowingly suffered such arrangement, and the conductor of the train, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and be punished accordingly."
